Cultivating Wholeness through Spiritual Practice

LISA COLÓN DELAY

Spiritual practices are wildly popular today—and for good reason. But they can lead to distressing encounters with wounds we didn't even know we had. In *The Wild Land Within* Lisa Colón DeLay engages spiritual practices from early desert monastics, as well as Latinx, Black, and indigenous contemplatives, to guide us in cultivating lives of devotion. Here theology and neuroscience help us work through buried fear or pain and find embodied spiritual healing.



LISA COLÓN DELAY is a teacher, spiritual director, and host of *Spark My Muse*, a top-rated religion and spirituality podcast. Originally from Puerto Rico, DeLay has an MA in spiritual formation and has taught

in many settings, from graduate schools to workshops. Her work has appeared in several anthologies and in dozens of places in print and online, and she offers spiritual companioning and retreats. DeLay lives with her family outside Philadelphia.
