Modified Sunday School is returning March 7th!

In an effort to bring back our Sunday routine, we will be offering Sunday School during our normal 9:15 time period with the following limitations. There will only be two options for Sunday School which will be described below and we are asking for people to sign up online at www.bethesdaec.org. The larger adult class will meet in Common Ground to allow for social distancing and the International Class will meet in their normal room, space permitting. Participants are asked to wear masks into the rooms and may remove them once seated. We ask that if you exhibit any symptoms of COVID that you refrain from attending. Children ages 4-4th grade will be meeting in the Library during this time, our 5th -7th grade class in the Cinema Room and our 8th-12th grade class will meet in the Café. Similar to our Worship Services, Nursery (0-3) will be a crying room available for parents to be with their children. Coffee will also not be served so we encourage you to bring it from home if you desire. We are excited to return to these amazing learning opportunities and look forward to seeing you there!


