#### A Survey of the Book of Revelation Sundays, November 7 - December 5 6:30 - 8 pm in the Sanctuary

What message does the book of Revelation hold for today's church? One of hope or gloom? Pictures of historical events or events yet to come? Many propose it tells us the end is near. So what is the central message of this mysterious book?

Dr. Buckwalter teaches biblical studies at Evangelical Seminary and has spent significant time researching and analyzing this apocalyptic letter to the seven churches. Join us for a series of five sessions concerning his survey of the book of Revelation.

Doug first began to teach at Evangelical in 1993, soon after returning to the States after finishing his post-graduate studies in Scotland with Prof. I. Howard Marshall. Before coming to Evangelical he was working as a free-lance editor with Walter A. Elwell and J. D. Douglas for Baker Book House and Zondervan Publishing House on various theological and biblical reference works.
