If the land next door is sold to a private owner or a business, they would have the right to object to the services and training done at the headquarters. Since Christianity is barely tolerated in this Hindu kingdom, things could be made very difficult for our churches there. Our goal is to raise \$10,000 towards the estimated purchase price of \$30,000. Please pray about this and see if your church, youth group or MMK group would like to help. More information will be forthcoming in the next few months.
- **Please pray** for our missionaries who are beginning to travel back to the field following brief visits home in the States in December and January. Travel is still a little tricky with newly instituted COVID-19 testing requirements prior to travel allowance for some airlines and some layover countries still closed to international travel. Pray for smooth travel itineraries and patience during last minute changes.

Academic Dean - Indian Bible College, Flagstaff, AZ

iblical, Relational, Transformational – foundational goals for Indian Bible College (IBC) in Flagstaff, AZ – and home to **Rev. Gene Stevenson**, its Academic Dean.

Founded in 1958, Indian Bible College is located in north-central Arizona, close to the largest Native American reservation in the United States. Over the course of its history, the school has seen over 120 graduates of the school, many of whom are still faithfully serving the Lord.

IBC exists to disciple and educate indigenous Native Christians for lifetimes of biblical ministry and spiritual leadership to their people and the world. The college provides the necessary training for accurate interpretation of God's Word so that students develop a BIBLICAL worldview and lifestyle; facilitates biblical development and maintenance of RELATIONAL lifestyles and ministries through intentionally modeling, mentoring, and training students with grace and truth; and strives to cultivate TRANSFORMATIONAL change in the lives of students through the internalization of biblical and relational principles.

IBC is unique in that it has as its central mission the training of Native Americans for Christian Leadership. This uniqueness is shown in the sensitivity of the staff in understanding the distinctive needs of Native students. The goal is "a high standard with a unique application of grace" - adjusting to the wide range of experience and cultural uniqueness of its students. While this can be a challenge, the centrality of Christ as the unifier of all cultures in the church makes this an endeavor well worth the effort.

Gene Stevenson serves as the college's academic dean. A graduate of Millersville University and Evangelical Seminary, Gene and his wife, Bethanie (Beth), along with their three children, Aria, age 14, Noah, 10, and Lily, 9, have called Arizona home since 2018.

Gene's responsibilities include supervising the Academic Department (registrar, faculty and library staff); working with the President and other administrative staff to implement and improve the IBC curriculum; working with the Student Life Department regarding enrollment, registration, student behavioral issues; leading chapel services multiple times a semester; writing and compiling material for accreditation; and teaching at least one course per semester.

Would you consider financial partnership with Gene? IBC staff raise their own support to keep costs low enough to enable students to graduate debt free. Gene, IBC's newer Academic Dean is very important to the growth of Indian Bible College!
